Maritime risk analysis



Risk assessment and security plans

Vessel security reviews

We have the skills and qualifications to provide consultancy on all threats our clients might face, including counter-piracy security design and vessel



hardening. We regularly undertake vessel security reviews and audits to ensure compliance with up to BMP 4 standards.

Counter-piracy operations
